Contractual Agreement and Rates for Host Families

The person with a disability would be treated as a family guest and not expected to contribute to the usual household expenses.

The host family will be reimbursed by the natural family for any actual expense incurred just for the individual guest for example purchases of medication, sanitary wear etc.

They would offer host family support in blocks of 24 hours - the minimum engagement being 24 hours.

There will be a contractual agreement between the family and host family.

The host family will complete a 'statement by a supplier form' as part of the agreement.

Section A: 3 - The supply is made by an individual or partnership without a reasonable expectation of profit or gain.

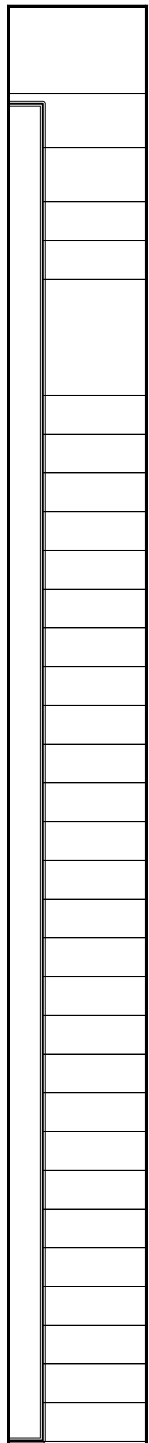
A minimum rate to be paid for a 24 hour

Host rate is: \$184.00

If the guest has higher needs or does not sleep through the night the rate can be negotiated but must be above the minimum rate.

This rate will be reviewed on a yearly basis (financial year).
